VOLUNTEERS - POLICY

Volunteer opportunities are available to students in 7th grade through high school who have community service obligations through a school or religious affiliation. Preference will be given to students who reside in the Nanuet School District or attend a school or religious institution located in the Nanuet School District. Out-of-district students may be accepted as needed. It is understood that volunteer opportunities are dependent on the library's need for help, the existence of appropriate tasks, and the availability of staff to train and supervise.

Volunteers eighteen (18) years of age and over will be required to submit to a background check, and complete a Background Check Disclosure, Authorization and Release Form provided by the Library; the Library may deny a volunteer position to any person who fails to complete such a Background Check Disclosure, Authorization and Release. Volunteers under the age of eighteen (18) years will be required to obtain and submit to the Library written, parental consent which is to be provided on a form furnished by the Library.

Volunteer work will generally be done in one-hour increments at the convenience of the library. Other arrangements can be made if the task demands it, with the permission of a Librarian or the Director.

Additional volunteer opportunities are available through membership in the Friends of the Library and the Teen Advisory Board. General volunteer opportunities through the Library are occasionally available depending on need and the availability of staff to train and supervise.
